In order to provide better professional development opportunities for CLTAC members, CLTAC Board recently decided to co-host the 2010 Chinese Language Education Forum (CLEF) in the Fall this year, in stead of independently holding its regular Fall Workshop. The other co-host organizations of the 2010 CLEF are the Chinese Language Education and Research Center (CLERC) and the Confucius Institute at San Francisco State University.

CLEF is to serve as a platform for Chinese K-16 teachers, heritage language instructors, policymakers, educational administrators, product and service providers in the field of Chinese language education from around the world to exchange new researches and fresh ideas and share creative teaching experience and professional development information. The forum will also highlight a comprehensive Chinese Language Materials Expo. Selected papers will be published after the forum. This year's CLTAC annual membership meeting will be held at this forum.

The 2010 CLEF welcomes proposals for presentation in either English or Chinese in the following topic areas:

- Curricula, materials, and articulation of different types of Chinese programs (immersion programs, foreign language programs, heritage language programs, college programs, etc)
- Pedagogy, technologies and classroom management
- New achievements and trends in Chinese language studies and their implications for teaching Chinese as a second language
- Cultural integration in Chinese language education
- Program development, teacher preparation and professional development, guest teachers, study abroad, and community outreach

For CLTAC members, CLEF has made special arrangements of extended deadline of proposal submission and discounted registration fee. The following are the details:
